



Piecing Together Desert Arc's History

Sixty years ago, in August of 1959 to be exact, a small group of determined parents in Palm Springs sought to enrich the lives of their children with developmental and intellectual disabilities as there were very few social, educational or recreational services in existence at that time. Desert Arc as it is known today was born through love and determination by these individuals to provide hope, purpose and fulfillment for their children.

Ten years later, they established our first formal vocational training workshop in Palm Desert in a facility built on property gifted by Clifford W. Henderson on Portola Avenue, now the home of the Center for Spiritual Living. Our vital social service agency received federal recognition by the IRS and was officially incorporated as a 501 (c) (3) charitable nonprofit organization in 1971.

In 1983, after outgrowing its original structure, operations expanded to a single new building on acreage generously donated by the Western Golf Association, on the site of our present-day Palm Desert campus on Country Club Drive just east of Monterrey. By 1999, the late President Gerald Ford was on hand to dedicate

the opening of an additional new 26,000 square foot building for client program space. Building 2 opened its doors in 2016.

In 2008, the name was changed to Desert Arc, reflecting a growing national respect for individuals with disabilities. Today, Desert Arc has sites in Indio (Recycling Center and Bus Yard), Palm Desert and Yucca Valley, and serves over 700 clients from the Coachella Valley, to the Morongo

Basin and independent programs and services from Temecula to Blythe.

There were 99 total campers in attendance last year under the guidance and support of Desert Arc's staff team encompassing 37 counselors and a nurse.
